Common Information Model (CIM) Package

The Common Information Model (CIM) package is a comprehensive set of tools and resources that helps server vendors, storage hardware vendors, and independent hardware vendors (IHVs) develop and certify a CIM provider running on an ESXi host.


CIM providers allow management functions such as reporting health monitoring information or updating driver firmware.

Nexii Labs offers CIM providers, testing and validation services for conformance with VMware Ready logo.

CIM testing process

The partner must submit information about their company and solutions using the IOVP questionnaire for VMware approval before starting the actual testing.

Standard Process followed



Test scenarios

Test suite execution covers multiple test scenarios including validating system resources by CIM enumeration, monitoring system health data, and performing upgrade operations on installed software.

- 01. Getting manufacturer, model and serial number of physical server via CIM
- **02.** Getting BIOS version via CIM
- **03.** Getting all the vSphere Installation Bundles (VIBs) that are installed on the managed server using CIM client
- **04.** Installing VIBs using CIM client applications
- **05.** Monitoring VIBs installation status

- **06.** Monitoring state of all sensors
- **07.** Reporting Fan Redundancy
- **08.** Reporting CPU Cores and Threads
- **09.** Reporting Empty memory slots
- **10.** Reporting the PCI Device Hierarchy By Using Parent DeviceIDs
- **11.** Reporting the Path to a PCI Device By Using PortGroups
- **12.** Monitoring RAID Controller State
- **13.** Reporting Accessible Storage Extents
- **14.** Working with the System Event Log
- **15.** Connections from Client to CIM Server
 - a. Using SLP
 - **b.** Using a Web Browser
 - c. Using CLI interface
- **16.** Verifying User Authentication Credentials
